

## Connect External Apps to ChatGPT Using Composio

### What is Composio?

Composio is an integration platform that connects ChatGPT with hundreds of external applications through the Model Context Protocol (MCP). Instead of switching between different websites and tools, Composio allows ChatGPT to securely access and interact with services such as Canva, Gmail, Google Drive, Notion, GitHub, Slack, and many others—all from within your chat.

### Step 1: Create a Composio Account

Visit <https://composio.dev/> and create a free account. Once you've signed in, you'll have access to the Composio dashboard.

### Step 2: Copy Your MCP URL

Open the **Install** tab in your Composio dashboard. Under the **MCP** section, you'll find your unique **MCP URL**. Copy this URL, as you'll need it to connect Composio with ChatGPT.

### Step 3: Enable Developer Mode in ChatGPT

Open **ChatGPT** and navigate to:

**Settings → Apps → Advanced Settings**

Enable **Developer Mode**.

### Step 4: Create a New App

Return to the **Apps** section and click **Create App**.

Complete the following fields:

- **App Name:** Composio
- **MCP URL:** Paste the URL you copied from Composio

Click **Create** (or **Save**) to finish the setup.

### Step 5: Connect Your Favorite Apps

Once the integration is complete, you can connect supported applications directly through ChatGPT. Depending on the integrations available to your Composio account, these may include:

- Canva
- AI Voice Generator

- Gmail
- Google Drive
- Notion
- Slack
- GitHub
- And hundreds of other supported services

After connecting an app, ChatGPT can interact with it directly, allowing you to complete tasks without leaving the conversation.
